


My child is happy at Cambrai Primary School.


My child does well at this school.




My child is taught well at school.




The school makes sure children are well behaved.




My child feels safe at school.


My child is well looked after by staff.


My child reads regularly at home.






The school has high expectations for my child.





Communication- **knowing all communication comes from one source**. Some are on Facebook, some are newsletter/ paper letter other are via email. Everything needs to be everywhere or needs a set way to ensure we are not searching which way the information has been given out.

Morning starts. If you reiterate school starts **welcoming children in from 8:45** it really does help working parents if this is adhered to so they can drop their child off and get to work. School is so important and seeing our children off happily but work balance is also important.

Mud! What are the children doing at playtime? Because they come home almost everyday filthy. It costs a lot of money for parents having to continually wash and replace clothing. The same with the year one and two side of entering school, the mud at the side of the walk path is becoming an issue for parents needing to get in and out everyday.

The only thing is when I ask my child what she's done at school, she says nothing, which is the norm however if **topics that are being taught are written in their book**, it would prompt me to ask her about it however, everything else I am so happy with

The only slight niggle I have is XXX coming home with a **super muddy coat**, I love the outdoors and all it has to offer however I do find it hard to keep on top of keeping her coat clean for school.

Nothing at the minute

More opportunities for after school activities they only get one per week

Open a nursery!

As much as it's great that the children play outside so much, it does become as issue when they are caked in **mud day after day**, other than this I have absolutely no complaints Cambrai is a fantastic school with amazing staff!
